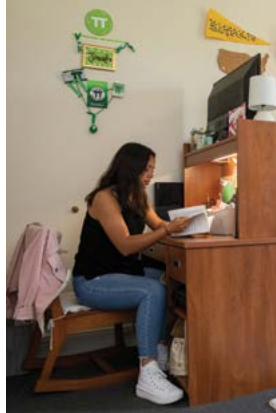

You be you! We will be there cheering you on!

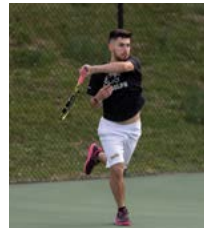
